THE HISTORY OF SCROUNGERS In the early 2000's Kymm Sweeting (then Club Captain) introduced "mid-week after work tennis" on Wednesday afternoon for men, this group was later coordinated by Stuart Oates. 20 odd players participated.

In 2006, social tennis was waning, in 2007 Grayden Clack was appointed Captain and Sally Ann Williams appointed mid-week coordinator, who then encouraged men to play Wed Social. Attendance increased for Wed Social, Scrounger numbers declined and so Thursday arvo Scroungers morphed.

Seeking a more competitive tennis experience Grayden introduced a team based Retro format for Spring and Autum. In 2014 the group trialled a modified two team event. Individuals nominate weekly to play, teams are selected, matches are played, Court 28 gets visited, fines are issued, and comradery is high!

2017, saw Fred La Rosa expand play to all year around.
